### Comments and Actions:

- Speeding is an ongoing problem. See chart above, speeders that were cited averaged driving 14.5 mph over the posted speed limit. Nine were on Worthington Lane and three on Stone School Road. Only one speeder was a resident. Running stop signs is still about half of the problem. Officer Hixon will continue to rotate hours to be proactive with this situation.
- Assisted LMPD 8<sup>th</sup> Division calls for service regarding young adults roaming the subdivision between 1:00am -3:00am.
- Assisted the Oldham County Police calls for service regarding; (a) young adults roaming the subdivision between 1:00am - 3:00am (b) in locating an elderly person who had walked into someone's home and then was roaming subdivision (c) in locating two subjects who ran off I-71 into a house in Moser Farms, they fled the scene, one subject was found injured was apprehended.
- I am still monitoring the MSD pump station during the late evening hours; young adults still using this area as a party site.
- Continued to conduct numerous house watches.

### Comments and Actions:
