If not they will be cited into court for the violation of Kentucky Revised Statutes.
- Speeding still seems to be the big problem within the subdivision all citations issued were for speeds nearing 40 mph.
- Vehicles traveling through the Estate Section on Worthington Lane at the Stone School Road intersection, do not **realize this is not a four way stop intersection** or fail to look up and down Stone School Road prior to moving into the intersection. There has been numerous near collisions during the summer months.
- The lake continues to see plenty of action with the warm weather – there were only two occasions that I found children NOT supervised by an adult using the lake. On both occasions they informed they had to leave or contact a parent to come be with them.
- I monitored the area next to the MSD pump station as it is a hot spot for young adults to park late nights and very early morning,
- I conducted numerous house watches.
